Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University, Pusa, Bihar

A historical institution of agricultural research, education, extension and entrepreneurship promotion, Pusa, Bihar is the birthplace of agricultural education and research. Although this journey started long back in the 18th century, the formal structured education in the form of an Agricultural Research Institute and College took shape in 1905. Continuing with this journey, the State Agricultural University in the name of Rajendra Agricultural University was set up in 1970 by the Govt. of Bihar. Acknowledging the contribution in agricultural education, research and extension, the Govt. of India upgraded this institution into a Central University in 2016 and renamed it as Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University. The University is recognized as an Institution of National Importance and is currently involved in agricultural education, research and extension in the country.

The academic set up of the university comprises of eight colleges, eight multi-disciplinary research centers/institutes, three regional research centers, in addition to six Sugarcane Testing centers attached with six sugar mills, 16 KVKs and Agricultural Technology Information Centre (ATIC). We are a fully residential campus, spread over an area of 1096 acres supporting rich biodiversity. Currently, more than 2000 students from 27 states of India are pursuing their education in various disciplines of Certification Courses, Diploma, Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral program.

The management education at Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University, Pusa (formerly Rajendra Agricultural University) started 17 years ago in 2006 with the launching of MBA (Agribusiness) degree programme by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar Sri Nitish Kumar Ji on 22nd July, 2006 under the Faculty of Basic Science and Humanities (FBS&H). Considering the importance of this programme and role of agricultural and rural management, a dedicated set up in the form of School of Agribusiness and Rural Management (SAB&RM) was established in 2018 with the launch of one more MBA programme in Rural Management. In 2016 it became Central University (an Institute of National Importance). School of Agribusiness and Rural Management (SAB&RM) was established under the Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University (RPCAU) from 2018. In 2020, a new technologically equipped building of SAB&RM was inaugurated by our Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji. The college is accredited by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).

This is among very few institutions in the country and unique among agricultural universities in India with both MBA (Agribusiness) and MBA (Rural Management) programme. This college is rated as a premier institution and imparts professional management education in the field of Agribusiness and Rural Management to generate entrepreneurs and to develop competent, socially responsible and qualified human capital for managing agribusiness and rural enterprises. The college has a history of placing its students in prominent business and development organizations.

Over the years, the school has achieved and excellence in student placement. Our students are placed with organisations of great repute, Nationally. Few of them have also got an opportunity to work for International organisations.





In 2023, all students of MBA (Rural Management) and MBA (Agribusiness Management) have been placed in reputed organizations well before the completion of the academic programme. In addition to running these two degree programmes, the college has also started Two Post Graduate Diploma Programmes (PGD) of One year in Agri Tourism Management (ATM) and Agri Journalism and Mass Communication (AJMC) in 2021.

SAB&RM is located within the premises of the University at Pusa, having its own building with state-of-the-art infrastructure, has well equipped teaching and research infrastructure such as smart classrooms, conference/seminar hall, auditorium with a 200 seating capacity, a dedicated library and computer lab along with other central facilities available in the University premises such as Central library, e-resources, playground, central auditorium, training hall, guesthouses, well-furnished hostels for students, University transportation facilities for students, cafeteria, gymnasium, dispensary, river front boating, parks and gardens, botanical garden, butterfly park, shopping complex etc.

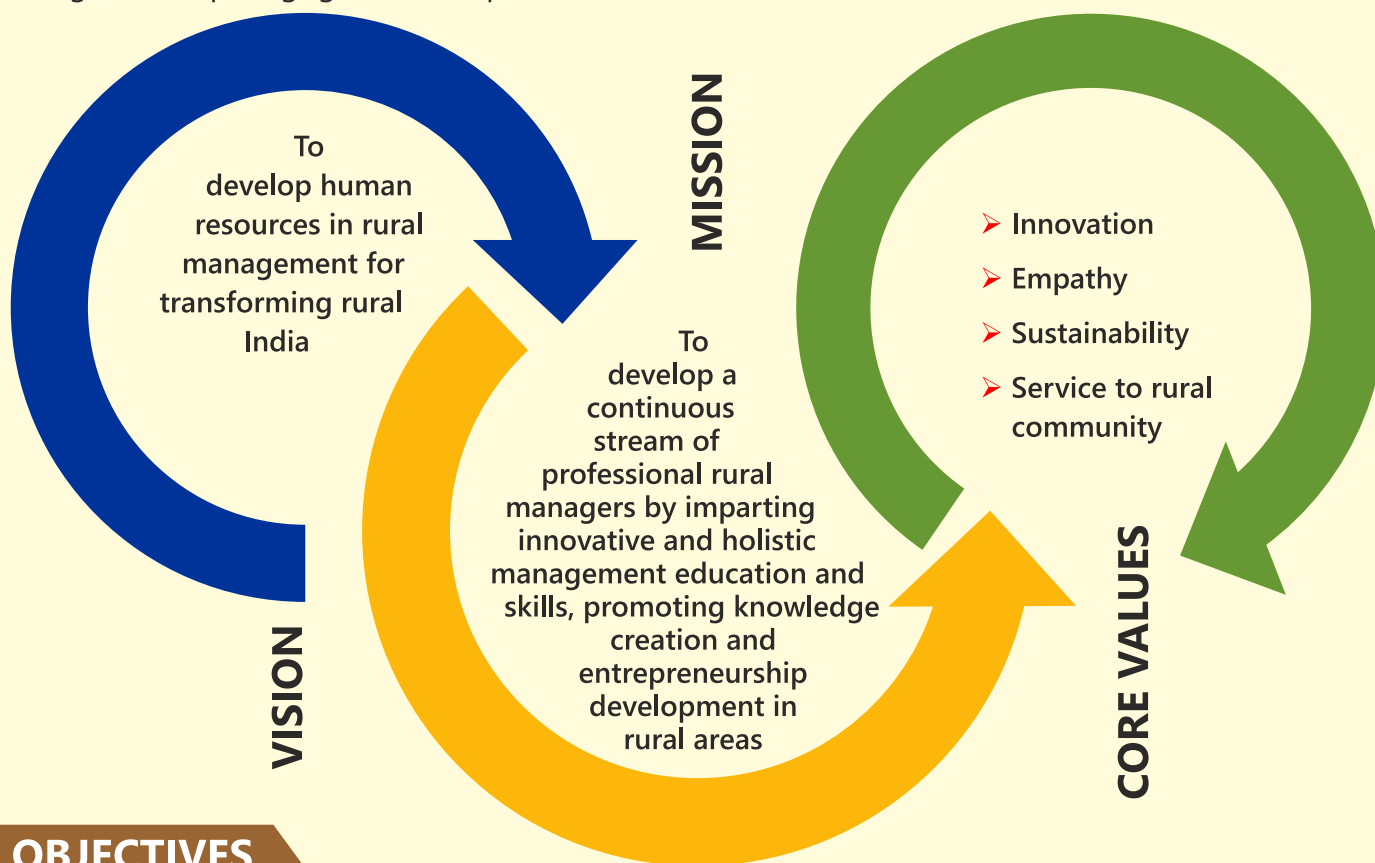


MBA (Rural Management)

MBA (Rural Management) was designed to understand the rural economy and to create managers who have the knowledge of business management and the ability to work in the rural sector. The Programme provides an extensive understanding of the rural context, communities, markets and opportunities, knowledge and skills to understand analyse and address complex problems in rural markets, develop and implement livelihood programme and social change strategies and also design to incubate and nurture social enterprises. Students learn to analyse managerial and developmental problems and develop insight, practical and innovative solutions to suit the requirement of rural mass.

MBA (Rural Management) was started in 2018 with an intake capacity of 30. It is a two-year residential postgraduate programme spanned over four different semesters including village fieldwork, development internship, and management traineeship. The first semester is a classroom component followed by three blended semesters (both classroom and experiential component) focusing on concepts, skills, and knowledge pertaining to rural development and management, using modern pedagogical techniques.

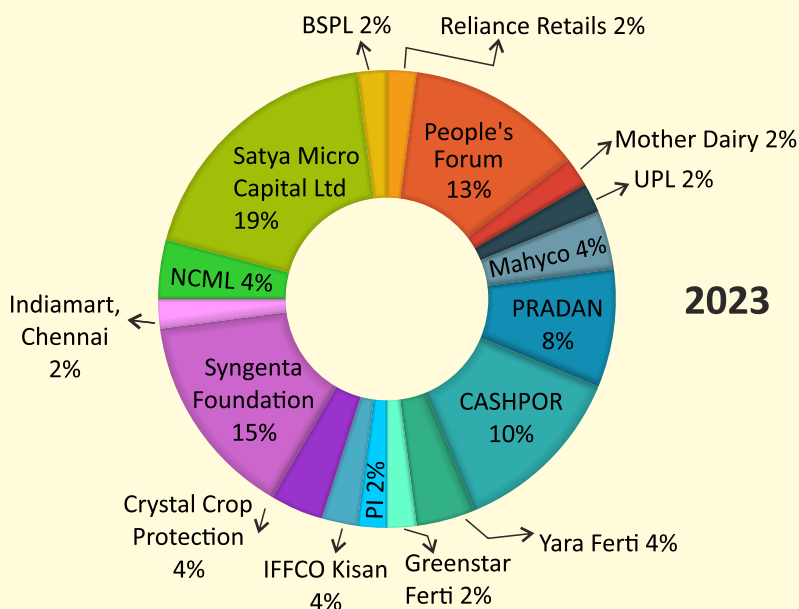

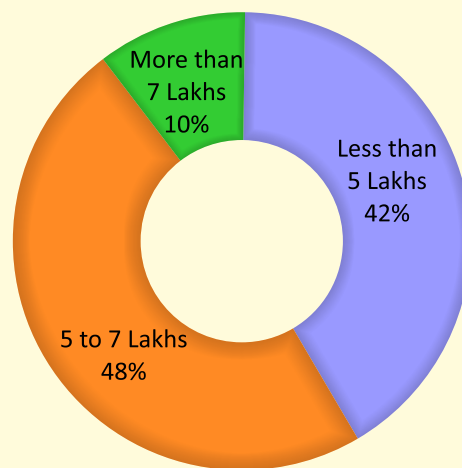

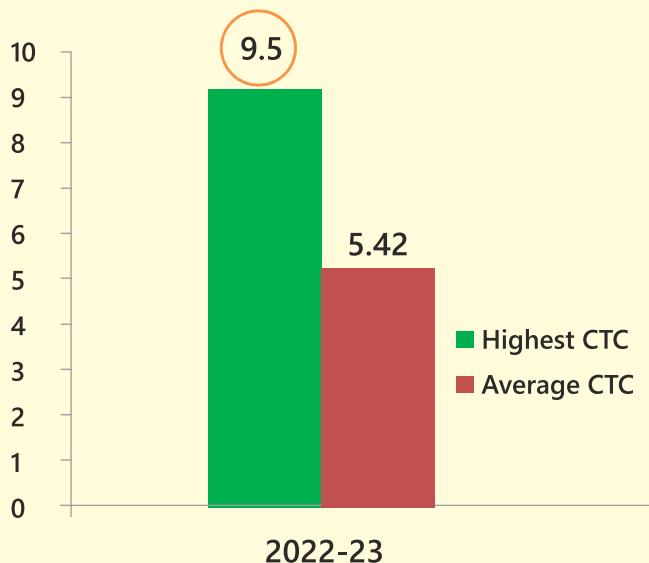
Campus Placement

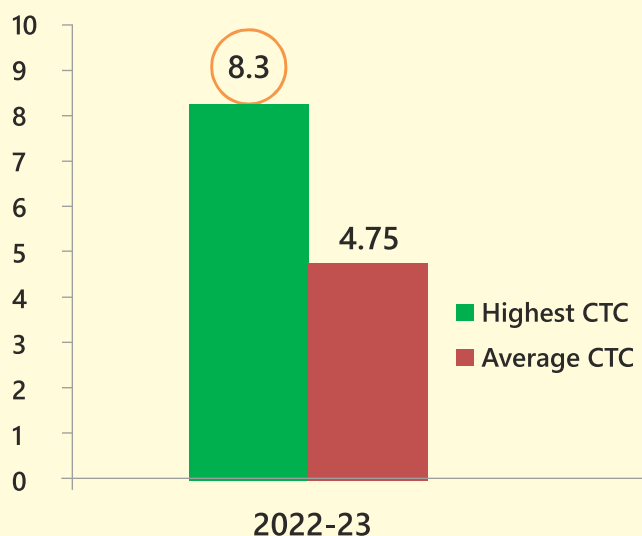
The average package for the MBA (Rural Management) stands at Rs. 4.75 LPA whereas the highest package was offered to a girl student, Ms. Sumona Roy which is Rs. 8.30 LPA with PRADAN. While, for MBA (Agribusiness), the highest package Rs. 9.50 LPA with UPL and average package of the batch is about Rs. 5.5 LPA.

Experiential Learning Segment

Experiential learning component is aimed at providing the students an opportunity to understand, learn and implement theory and practices of rural management in the real rural setting/ environment. Students are expected to work on chosen projects guided by a faculty member in association with rural business organisations and development-oriented institutions. Three experiential learning modules in the form of Internship / Project Work are included as a part of the 2 year MBA (Rural Management) programme.

Field Internship: This involves association with the Krishi Vigyan Kendras of our University during the First Semester of the MBA Programme. There are two components under this internship namely Village Experience Segment and Rural Action Component. In Village Experience Component the students understand the overall dynamics of a village society through various tools such as Participatory Rural Appraisal and develop a village level perspective plan. In Rural Action Component, the students undertake a project related to rural areas in consultation with the organization and the University.

Summer Internship: This is a 6-week programme undertaken during 2nd Semester in association with organizations working in development theme in rural areas such as Cooperatives, Social enterprises, NGOs etc.

Project Work: This programme is undertaken as a component of 4th Semester in association with commercial organizations working in development sector or development organization. Students take up a study related to business problems in association with such organizations. These Projects are mentored by both the college and the host organization.

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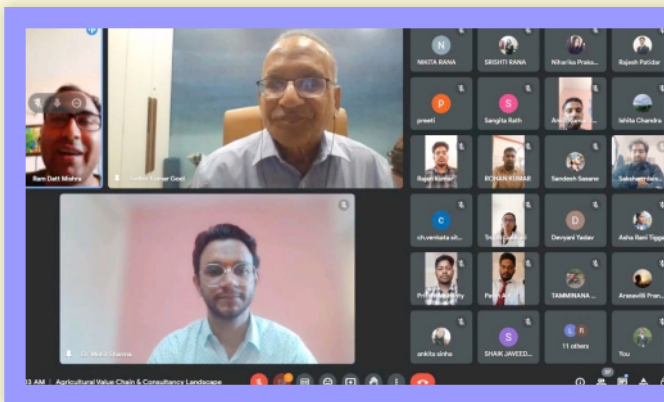

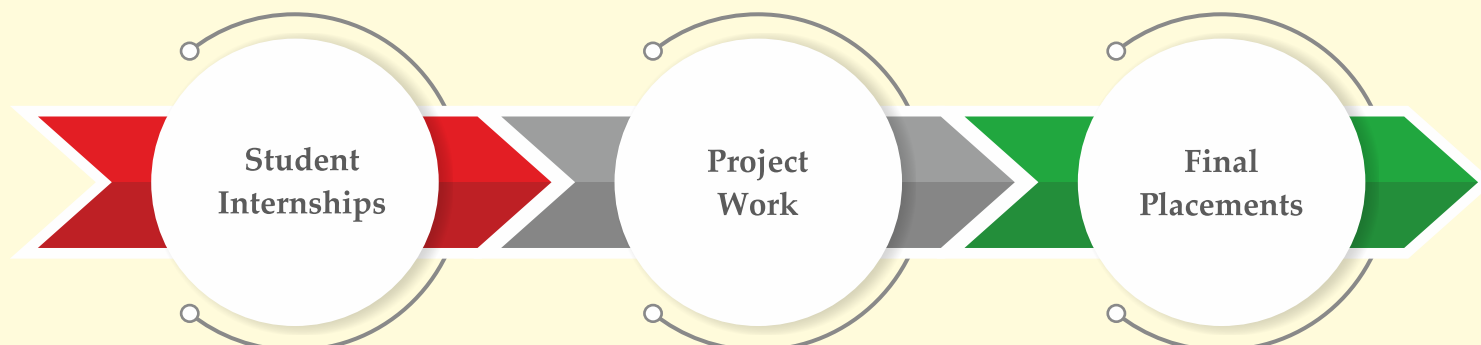

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION IN MBA (RURAL MANAGEMENT) PROGRAMME

RPCAU, Pusa Samastipur, Bihar invites application from motivated students for admission to MBA in Rural Management Programme under School of Agribusiness & Rural Management for the Academic Session 2024-25.

A. Eligibility

- The candidate must have passed Bachelor degree (four years course) in agriculture and allied sciences.
- The General, OBC and EWS candidates must have secured OGPA of at least 6.60/10.00.
- The SC/ST/PWD (person with disability) candidates must have secured at least 5.60/10.00.
- Where grade points are not awarded, the General, OBC and EWS candidates should have secured at least 60% marks whereas for SC/ST/PWD (person with disability) candidates it will be 50% marks.
- Besides the above conditions, the candidates must have appeared in CAT/MAT/CMAT /ICAR AIEEA-PG examination.

B. Selection procedures

Out of 100 marks, the candidates must have secured the minimum score as follows:

- UR : 60 marks
- OBC-NCL/EWS : 55marks
- SC/ST/PWD : 50 marks

C. Age Limit :

As per ICAR guidelines for PG admission through AIEEA, the minimum Age Limit is 19 years as on 31st July of Academic Year for Indian Nationals

D. Reservation

Reservation is applicable as per Govt. of India rules.

E. Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is only English. Hence a candidate must have a fluency in English reading, speaking and writing.

This programme is fully residential and it is mandatory for the students to stay in the University campus. The University has hostel facilities.

G. Application

Fee for General / OBC candidates is ₹1000/- and for ST/SC candidates is ₹500/-.
