

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

Vikshit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan (VKSA)

The nationwide pre-Kharif "Vikshit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan (VKSA)" campaign launched by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India, was flagged off by Hon'ble Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shri Ramnath Thakur in the presence of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Dr. P.S. Pandey at Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University, Pusa on 29th May 2025. A total of 38 teams of scientists have been formed at Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University. Each team have 5 to 6 scientists of different disciplines, who are visiting 3 villages in a day and will reach to about 1.90 lakh farmers. In the inaugural occasion, the Hon'ble minister emphasized that we need to reach the doorsteps of the farmers to understand their problems and identify researchable issues. Speaking on the occasion, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor said that the university is committed to the progress of farmers. Our scientists are actively participating in this campaign so latest technology can reach the farmers. On this occasion, Shri Ram Nath Thakur, Hon'ble Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, officially flagged off the vehicle of scientists along with RPCAU Krishi Gyan Vahan (KGV) on its journey across different villages of Samastipur and other districts of Bihar, carrying the message and mission of the (VKSA). The campaign aims to promote scientific farming practices, ensure technology transfer, and build awareness about government schemes and sustainable agriculture.

The National Seminar on "Litchi Diversity and GI-Based Litchi Honey" was organized on 24th and 25th May 2025 at Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University, Pusa in collaboration with ICAR–National Research Centre on Litchi, Muzaffarpur and sponsored by the National Bee Board under Mini Mission-III of NBHM. The event featured the presence of dignitaries Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr P.S. Pandey, Chief Guest Dr. Prabhat Kumar (Horticulture Commissioner, GoI), Dr Bikas Das, Director, ICAR-NRC, who acknowledged the significant contributions of RPCAU and ICAR-NRC on Litchi in advancing litchi cultivation and promoting GI-based litchi honey.

Around 60 varieties of litchi were exhibited in stalls

showcasing litchi varietal diversity and honey products by various institutions and farmer groups. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor emphasized the growing economic value of litchibased honey and the need for innovation and farmer-level technologies to enhance production and income at the farm gate. Various technical sessions were held followed by expert lectures from renowned scientists, focusing on production, value addition, post-harvest handling, and export potential which were attended by several students, scholars, farmer groups, young scientists and entrepreneurs with a total presence exceeding 300 stakeholders. The event concluded with an engaging litchi-eating competition for students and the faculties.
